29th Congress of the European Simmental Federation 2011 – Udine

Dear colleagues and breeder friends,

once again the Italian Federation A.N.A.P.R.I. has been entrusted with the organisation of an international meeting of our Federation. We started in 1966 with the General Assembly in Padova, then came the World Federation Conference in 1980, the Congress of the European Federation in Grado in 1991, followed by Verona in 1995, and in 2011 we have the pleasure and honour of organising the 29th Congress of the European Simmental Federation.

After our first meeting in Padova in 1966 the Simmental Fleckvieh – Pezzata Rossa breed has gone a long way...from a few thousand registered cows scattered across the historical breeding areas of Friuli and South Tyrol, the population has now grown to 60.000 heads – and the breed can be found all over Italy.

There are many reasons for the success of this cattle breed - and not only in Italy. First of all the selection objective which still translates into dual purpose breeding in the majority of the European countries.

During the past years this selection objective has become a distinct product specialization that encompasses several economic factors which in turn influence animal efficiency considerably: longevity, fertility, stress resistance, udder health, and last but not least meat production...these are all relevant features of modern Simmental cattle!

In the '70s we had 10.000 registered cows in Italy, by 2010 the number had grown to over 60.000. Milk production has more than doubled over the same period of time: from 3.000 kg to 6.500 kg of milk, while maintaining the same quality in terms of fat and protein.

The progress made in every country is paramount to the success of the Simmental cattle. It also proves the versatility and the great environmental compliance of this breed.



During the 29th Congress several scientific and technical papers will focus on new selection methodologies that will soon be available thanks to progress in molecular genetics.

The Congress programme foresees also technical tours to farms and cattle stations, including the cattle breeding farm "Azienda Agricola Marianis-Volpares", where approximately 700 Simmental-Pezzata Rossa animals are bred. The farm is managed by the Regional Agency for Rural Development, a public body founded by the Region of Friuli Venezia Giulia. This farm is an important experimental livestock breeding center and, in general, a scientific research and development facility. Another important event will be the technical tour of the Artificial Insemination Center in Moruzzo, near Udine. The Center is managed by the Cattle Breeder's Association of Friuli Venezia Giulia. The latest outcomes of the Italian selection programme will be shown during the visit.

The Congress will end with the visit to the Livestock Show in Bolzano where we will have the opportunity to celebrate the 45th anniversary of the local Association of Simmental-Pezzata Rossa Breeders with our South Tyrolian friends.

On behalf of the Italian Federation A.N.A.P.R.I. we have the pleasure and honour of inviting you to the 29th Congress of the European Simmental Federation.

We hope for lively participation and look forward to meeting you in Udine next spring. Best wishes.

TECHNICAL FARM TOURS

BIANCHINI BROS.

The Bianchini Brothers farm is located in the small hamlet of Flumignano which is part of the municipality of Talmassons (population: 3000). The farm lies in the very center of the Friuli Venezia Giulia region and is surrounded by the Friulian plains. The city of Udine is close by. The property is completely irrigated and has medium textured soil.

MANAGED BY the Bianchini Family, 2 brothers (Fabrizio and Gabriele) + parents (Lisetta and Marcello) + 1 uncle (Enzo).

UAA (Utilised Agricultural Area) 70 ha; 40 ha of which are leased. They are divided as follows: 40 maize (13 silage, 7 maize mash and 20 maize grain), 15 alfalfa, 10 barley

(soybeans as intercrop), 5 poplar.

ANIMAL HOUSING


Free-stall system. Cow cubicles with cow mattress and grid floor. Rubber coverage in 80% of the dairy cattle area. 50° herringbone milking parlour with 14 stalls, rear milking.

LIVESTOCK POPULATION 160 head of cattle, 76 of which are lactating cows. INSEMINATION 100% AL

MILK SALES 80% to a nearby cheesemaking facility that produces a typical local cheese, as well as Stracchino and Mozzarella; 20% (yearly average) to artisan icecream producers in the province of Udine.

2009 PRODUCTION DATA (from the AIA Bulletin) 87 controlled cows; 7219 kg milk, 3,90 % fat, 3,47 % protein, 116 days service-period ("days open"), 205.000 somatic cells.

FEEDING COMPOSITION FOR DAIRY COWS (Unifeed for 27 kg milk daily) Maize silage: 23,0 kg; alfalfa hay: 4,5 kg; maize mash: 5,0 kg; protein concentrate feed: 2,2 kg; cottonseed: 2,0 kg; concentrated feed: 0,5 kg; yeast 30 g; bicarbonate and mineral salts as needed.



ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION CENTER IN MORUZZO

The Regional Center for Artificial Insemination (Region of Friuli Venezia Giulia) is located in the small village of Pradis near Moruzzo. We are in the vicinity of the city of Udine, surrounded by the morainal hills of Friuli which form a natural health barrier. The Center has almost 40 years experience in animal reproduction.

DESCRIPTION: The Center has an agricultural surface of 19.38 ha, 50% of which are fenced-in. The buildings comprise 4 dwellings for the staff of the Center, 100 boxes in two stables for the bulls in semen production and awaiting progeny testing, 60 boxes for swine reproduction and 26 boxes for horses.

Other buildings house the offices, three labs (bulls-swine-horses), storage facilities, barns and other stables. The lab equipment has been purchased recently and uses state of the art software that allows for very accurate and comprehensive donor assessment (CASA - Sperm Vision). The filling of the paillettes is done by a 4 needle device (MPP Quattro) and a new German made MT semen freezer is used. At present the Center has 10 employees with different tasks: a coordinator, lab personnel, health supervisors, general and temporary workforce.

SPECIES AND BREEDS AT THE CENTER: Cattle: Italian Simmental, Italian Brown, Italian Holstein, Belgian Blue, Charolais, Limousin. Equines: Norico, Rapid Heavy Draft, Haflinger, Trotters, Sport Ponies, Donkey.

CURRENT OBJECTIVES: Production of semen material with elevated biological and sanitary standards. Certification of the complete semen production process. Experimental activity and competitive presence on the Al-market.

PRODUCTION AND QUALITY ASSURANCE FOR SEMEN:

Approximately 300.000 doses of bovine semen are produced yearly, 50%





of which belong to Italian Simmental. Quality control of the semen is done by a third party that checks the correct self-certification and identification of the bull by comparing bull DNA obtained from the blood with that of the semen. The self-certification includes the following data: animal registration number, semen batch, total concentration, progressive motility, progressively motile sperm count.

THE CENTER'S ROLE IN THE SELECTION OF THE ITALIAN

SIMMENTAL: Production of semen doses for artificial insemination obtained from all the bulls that passed the performance-test at the ANAPRI Genetics Center in Fiume Veneto. Distribution of the semen doses as indicated in the selection scheme "Young Bulls" (2000 doses per bull) for about 30 bulls per year. Storage of the semen doses until progeny testing is completed (2000 bull doses). Semen delivery to the Breeder's Association Office in Codroipo near Udine to be sold all over Italy. Distribution of positive domestic and foreign bull semen doses to be used for guided matings in Italian breeding farms.

Production and exportation of bull semen doses for international exchanges.







GENERAL INFORMATION

FRIULI VENEZIA GIULIA

Being located at the North-Eastern corner of Italy the Friuli Venezia Giulia Region has been influenced by the different peoples and cultures that once dominated this area. The region is divided into 4 provinces: Trieste, Udine, Pordenone and Gorizia. Important historical remnants and traces of the Romans, Celts, and Longobards are to be found all over the region. By tradition it is an agricultural area, though important industrial developments took place in the second half of the 20th century (steel factories, shipyards, timber and wood). Today, family and artisan businesses, small and medium enterprises and a thriving service industry are the backbone of the region's economy. Although the number of people employed in agriculture has shrunk noticeably, it still plays a vital role not only for economical reasons, but also with regard to land conservation and management. The agriculture and food industry sectors make intelligent use of technological innovation but consider product quality always a top priority. From this region come internationally renowned products such as the San Daniele ham, Montasio cheese, and famous wines - just to name a few.






